## **Environmental Policy Statement**

The materials used range from steels, plastics, paints, electronic components and rubber, plus various lubricants and adhesive products.

Our aim at Linde is for continual improvement in Environmental Performance, including protection of the environment. This includes, where possible, preventing pollution at source, taking into consideration business objectives, employees, the local community and continual improvement of the Environmental Management System.

In particular -

- 5 Any processes where environmental concerns exist, where practicable, will be eliminated. If this is not possible, suitable and sufficient controls will be introduced to minimise damage or nuisance,
- 6 To ensure that future manufacturing processes and related service activities are given due environmental consideration.
- 7 To ensure that any site contractors meet the requirements of the Linde Environmental Policy.
- 8 To communicate this policy to our customers and suppliers, to encourage their involvement and approval and to consider their conformity to this policy in our selection.
- 9 To promote and encourage policy awareness amongst employees and increase awareness by improvement Training.
